Prerequisite: Open GO-Kit and read instructions included with the GoKit OR read online instructions under Build Info tab on StAlbertSoapBoxDerby.ca website. Reading the instructions before the Build Day will get you the basics and allow you to get your guestions answered.

\*\*\*\*\*May 20<sup>th</sup> is final day to withdraw and receive your \$35 registration fee back.

2) In order to race, your cart(s) AND all driver(s) **MUST** attend the June 10, 2023 Cart INSPECTION DAY inspection, weighing and driver DAY, JUNE IOTH FROM 2-SPM at naki transit centre testing at NAKI transit parking lot.

Please remember to bring your racer(s) helmets.

Naki Transit Centre is located at 15520 Campbell Road NW from 2-5PM. Look for the tents and signs to direct you to unloading and inspection areas.

3) REMINDER: For 2023, Carts need to weigh between 60 and 80 lbs. This is a reduction from the 100 lbs from previous years. Official Weigh in happens as Inspection on June 10.

**SPECIAL OFFERING** : On Saturday May 20 (only), you can bring your cart to Fountain Tire and get a reading on your cart weight. Times 2-3 PM and then after the Build session at 4:00 PM.

- 4) June 17 racing schedule is published AFTER Inspection weekend.
- 5) REMINDER: Practice racing is possible on Friday June 16 after hill is setup. In 2022, Friday night practice racing started around 7:30. Security is present Friday night on the hill so Soapbox recommend you store your cart overnight on the hill. (suggest you bring a tarp/cover for your cart)
