There will be a number of changes considered (older racer category, Rules review and update – weight reduction of carts, Site layout, Safety, Spectator areas, registration fee....), researched and implemented to make Soap Box better. Volunteers on the WG get to see and have input into the changes.

The 2023 high level plan is to keep much of the 2022 format including two racer days which would be **Friday June 16 and Saturday June 17, 2023.** Expect a high level timeline before Christmas! 2022 had 86 racers in a two day format. With a two day format going forward, the WG is looking to grow participation to 150.
